

**Washington West Supervisory Union
Immunization Rates for School Year 2014-2015**

Immunizations are required for enrollment in all Vermont schools in order to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. The Vermont Legislature passed a requirement in 2012 that all schools must make immunization rates for the student body available to the public. The information below for our seven schools identifies the percentage of students who have been fully vaccinated and the percentage fully vaccinated for each individual vaccine. For purposes of comparison, the percentage of all Vermont students enrolled in kindergarten and seventh grade who received the required vaccines is also presented. Effective July 1, 2016, Vermont's philosophic exemption from school and child care immunizations will be eliminated.

DTaP/Tdap - DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis) 5 doses, and Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) 1 dose\ in grades 7 through 12

Polio - 4 doses

MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) - 2 doses

Hep B - (hepatitis B) - 3 doses

Varicella (chickenpox) - 2 doses or documentation of history of disease

Meningococcal - 1 dose for residential students in grades 7 through 12

Fully Immunized - percentage of students meeting all vaccine and dose requirements
